For whom?

Programme

The Amsterdam MBA programme is a combination of theory and practice. Its curriculum consists of a core curriculum, electives, a study trip, careers coaching and the Amsterdam Leadership Programme. You will gain all knowledge and skills needed to become a future leader in business and society. The International Full-time MBA core curriculum takes place during the day, with most classes from 14:00 to 17:30, four days a week, from Monday to Thursday.

Core Curriculum

The core curriculum consists of four domains addressing various key challenges for future leaders in business and society. You will become an expert in Leadership Qualities, Strategic Thinking, Quantitative Skills and managing Contemporary Challenges.

Electives

The following electives are offered: International Consulting Trip, M&A and Restructuring, Entrepreneurial Finance, Corporate Venturing, Scaling-up Businesses, Innovation Management and Product Management. All electives are taught in the evening (18:30-22:00) with the exception of the International Consulting Trip. A minimum of two electives has to be selected.

The Amsterdam MBA

The content of the MBA is always the same. We offer the MBA in 2 different formats:

International MBA	Executive MBA (EMBA)
Full-time, 12 months	Part-time, 24 months on-campus or Part-time, 24 months hybrid

Workload

The International Full-time MBA covers about 50 hours per week. This includes four classes a week, taught during the day (13:30 to 17:00) from Monday to Thursday. Classes are separated from the EMBA students, with the exception for electives. Apart from the International Consulting Trip, electives are always taught in the evening, from 18:30 to 22:00.

Amsterdam Leadership Programme (ALP)

The ALP is about developing your personal and professional leadership skills, building unique leadership talents and gaining top management insights. The idea is not to provide a single 'correct' perspective, but rather to encourage personal reflection and insight critical for future work and personal success.

International Study Trip to South Africa

During this one-week trip to Cape Town, you deep-dive into a vibrant ecosystem and experience business operations in an emerging market.







Admission steps and timeline

Our admissions team will coach you through every step of the admissions process. The admission steps are as follows:

1. Submit online application
2. LTP Assessment
3. Admissions Interview

The admissions process takes around two to four weeks, depending on your own input and follow-up. Typically, the admissions team responds within 48 hours.
